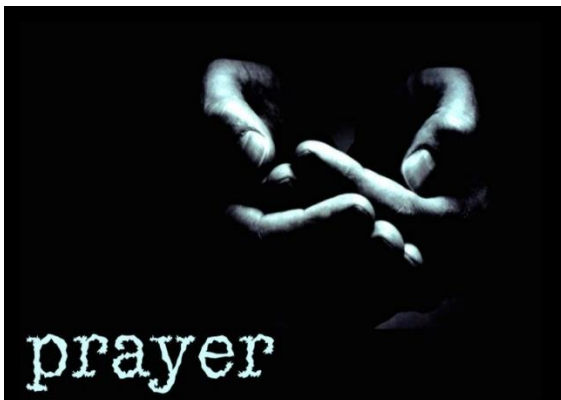

Volunteer orientations are back! Anyone who has been hesitating, now is your chance to get involved and bring some joy to a senior who needs a ride, shopping or a SMILE.

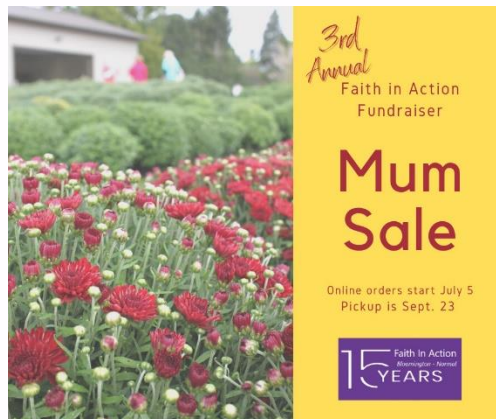
